Senior Care of Sacramento provides a consulting and placement service to seniors and their families to help locate suitable residential care facilities. Our goal is to match the senior's needs and care requirements with the appropriate care facility/provider. We specialize in assessing the physical, mental, budget and geographical needs of the senior. Care options include: (1) in-home care services, (2) Assisting Living facilities, (3) Board and Care homes, (4) Memory Care residences, and (5) Retirement communities.

We understand the stress and anxiety working with family members as well as the needs of the senior. We will be able to answer most of your questions and allay the fears accompanying the difficult decisions, which need to be made.

The residential care facilities that we select for a senior and/or their family to visit are licensed and inspected by the California Department of Social Services. Our facility qualification process includes interviewing the administrator, inspecting the facility and completing our facility questionnaire. When appropriate, we review a facility's file at the Department of Social Services Community Care Licensing division office.

Senior Care of Sacramento service is provided to the senior and their family for no cost or obligation. When a referred placement is made the care facility pays **Senior Care of Sacramento** a referral fee. For personal assessments and consultation only, there is a fee. Our consulting, referral and placement services operate as follows:

- We interview and assess each senior's physical, mental and medical requirements along with family and social services needed.
- We identify those facilities which will provide the most appropriate level of care for each senior based on their care needs, budget and geographical locations for the convenience of family visitations.
- We provide each family with a list of appropriate state licensed facilities, which we have identified, along with copies of appropriate state forms and our Facility Evaluation Check List which contains questions to ask at each facility.
- Each senior and their family select the residential facility they prefer for the senior to reside in. **Senior Care of Sacramento** will not recommend a specific facility. The facility selected by the senior to reside in pays **Senior Care of Sacramento** a referral fee.

We usually provide a list of at least three to five qualified faculties for each family to visit. Our firm has received numerous testimonial letters from people whom we have assisted in locating assisted care facilities for their elderly loved ones.

There are over 500 state licensed care facilities available in the Sacramento and surrounding counties including facilities that specialize in caring for people with Alzheimer's and other dementia.
